Night 1: Nairobi, Giraffe Manor – Start your safari the moment you arrive! Hand-feed tall friends at this lovely Colonial mansion

Nights 2 to 4: Samburuland, hang with real warriors (track animals, dance into the night), get up close and personal with elephant families our guides know by name, and have a chance at seeing the big cats (helicoptering an option here, too!)
